Robert Parker has rated the Jordan CWG Sophia Auction Reserve 2001 wine 91+ points in his revered newsletter the *Wine Advocate*.

Named "Sophia" after the legendary mother of Faith, Hope and Charity, and representing the characteristics of the three Bordeaux varieties that make up this exceptional wine, the Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot were blended together and aged for a total of 26 months in 225-litre French oak barrels.
